02\ First Results from "Intelliekon" on EEDAL 2009

First results from the Smart Metering project "Intelliekon" were presented at EEDAL 2009 (Energy Efficiency in Domestic Appliances and Lighting) in Berlin. "Intelliekon" is a joint project of Fraunhofer-Institute for Solar Energy Systems (ISE) and ISOE. Researchers investigate if Smart Metering in combination with feedback information to consumers promotes sustainable energy consumption. 03\ Gender Study on Sustainable Consumption
